Time to Plant Seed Mckinley Pate

It is that time of year again. Spring is here and many are looking forward to getting their favorite “garden spot” ready. In just a few short months, many will reap the harvest of field peas, corn, potatoes, and other vegetables. As we think of our gardens, we know that we must plant seed in hopes of having a good crop. And although we may plant many seeds, not all will take root and grow into the full grown plant that we desire to have and to harvest. But when we think in a spiritual sense, Christ spoke a parable to his disciples. We know the parable as the Parable of the Sower. **“A sower went out to sow his seed: and as he sowed, some fell by the way side; and it was trodden down, and the fowls of the air devoured it. And some fell upon a rock; and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away, because it lacked moisture. And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprang up with it, and choked it. And other fell on good ground, and sprang up, and bare fruit an hundredfold. And when he had said these things, he cried, He that hath ears to hear, let him hear,”** Luke 8:5-8. Christ tells us what the spiritual seed is. **“Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God,”** Luke 8:11. Christ continues to explain to the disciples the parable which He had just told to them. When we plant Spiritual seed, we must realize that it is not always going to take root and produce spiritual fruit. **“Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved. They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away. And that which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection. But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with patience,”** Luke 8:12-15. When we spread the Word of God, we must not get discouraged when we do not see immediate results. Sometimes all we can do is plant the seed. **“I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase,”** 1 Corinthians 3:6. Let us remember that although we must wait until spring to plant our physical seeds and crops, every season is the perfect time to plant the seed of God. Let us strive every day to sow the seed of Christ to as many people possible.

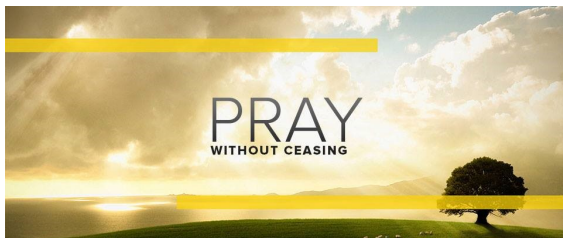

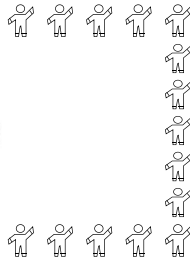
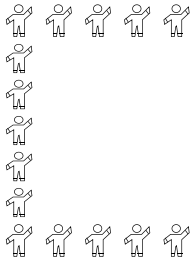
