There is just something about hearing your name. On some occasions, it is scary. If your mom or dad ever called you by your whole name—first, middle, and last—you were probably in big trouble.

Why in the world do parents, grandparents, and other family and friends sit through hours of a ceremony hearing a person they don't know reading countless names of more people they don't know?
