The Mark of the Beast Mckinley Pate

Next on our Premillennial list is the misinterpretation of the mark of the beast found in Revelation 13:16-18. According to the Premillennialist when the Antichrist comes into power all of his followers will be marked with the numbers 666 on their foreheads and their right hand. Recently, however, many have taken the Premillennialist stance and have misrepresented it to say that the mark of the beast will happen before the "so-called" Antichrist and when you receive it you will be doomed to hell! It almost reads like a horror film script. In the past some have stated that the mark of the beast will come in the form of a tattoo or even a cell phone (I guess if you are left handed then you're in the clear). Even recently there are rumblings that the mark of the beast is coming in the form of COVID testing (as some have stated that when you are test for the virus, a tiny chip is really being placed in your brain, trust me I'm rolling my eyes as I type that) or that it will come in the form of the vaccine for the coronavirus (again eye rolls).

So what does the Bible really say about the mark of the beast? "He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, and that no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man: His number is 666," Revelation 13:16-18. Again we must remember two things about studying the Bible. Number I, not everything in the Bible can be applied to me and to this moment in time. Here is an example, "they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover," Mark 16:18. I can promise you if I pick up a serpent or drink something deadly, I will die. Mark 16:18 does not apply to me. Number 2, not everything in the Bible can be taken as literal. Example, "Get out and depart from here, for Herod wants to kill You." And He said to them, "Go, tell that fox," Luke 13:31-32. Trust me Herod was not a literal fox. Therefore, here in Revelation 13, we must look at who the audience is. It is the 1st century Christians. Many believe that the mark of the beast belong to the Roman Emperor Nero and that the marking was a pagan custom to show their allegiance to something or someone. The number 6 in the Bible means incomplete, therefore 666 is very incomplete.


