The 144,000 of Revelation Mckinley Pate

As we continue our look at the false doctrine of Premillennialism, we must take a step back. As you recall, we looked at the so-called seven years of tribulation last week. Typically I would go right into talking about the Antichrist and the mark of the Beast, however, that will have to wait another week. I would not be doing this study justice if I did not talk about the 144,000.

Premillennialist believe that when Christ comes to secretly rapture the saints that only 144,000 will go to Heaven, while the rest are whist away to Paradise. The 144,000, according to their teaching, will only be made up of direct descendants of the twelve tribes of Israel. This comes, again, from taking the book of Revelation out of context and a misinterpretation of Revelation 7:3-4 "saying, "Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees till we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads." And I heard the number of those who were sealed. One hundred and forty-four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel were sealed:" The 144,000 are again mentioned in Revelation 14:1, "Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads."

The problem with this thinking is no where does it say that only 144,000 will be in heaven. Also if those who make up this number must be Jews, then Jesus lied in Matthew 8:11 when He said "And I say to you that many will come from east and west, and sit down with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven." Abraham, Isaac and Jacob were not of the twelve tribes even though Jacob was the father of the twelve tribes, he, himself, was not apart of them.

Another problem is that if we take the 144,000 literally, then no Gentile, which includes you and me will be in Heaven as we are not Jews. This again makes Jesus' statement about those from east and west a lie (Matthew 8:11). And last Revelation 14:4 states that the 144,000 will be only male virgins. This will exclude all women including Mary and Dorcus and all married men including Moses and Peter.

So who is the 144,000. In simple terms, it is the completeness of the saved. Remember in the Bible the number 12 and the number 1000 means completeness. 12 times 12 times 1000 equals all the saved!


