Hurlbut writes "More battles have been fought on the plain of Megiddo than on any other in the world." Barak defeated the Canaanites, Gideon defeated the Midianites and Saul was defeated by the Philistines. In the valley Ahaziah died and Pharaoh-Necho overthrew Josiah. One of the many problems is the fact that the valley of Megiddo is only 280 square miles, that's six (6) times smaller than Rhode Island. All the world can't fit in that confined area. We must also remember that Christianity versus Satan is a spiritual war not a physical one. Paul wrote "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this

age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places," Ephesians 6:12. The idea of Armageddon is the fact that Christ always wins and will win in the end over Satan and those who follow him. This gave comfort to those living under horrible persecution in the first century and hope to us living

now!


