The 1000 year reign of Christ Part I Mckinley Pate

Next stop on the Premillennialism falsehood train is the 1000 year reign of Christ. Premillennialist state that after the rapture, tribulation and Armageddon that Christ will return and reign literally on the Earth for 1000 years and that in said years there will be complete peace. Where do they get this and is that possible.

First of all, let me say that I can not put God into a box, however, God can put himself into a box. If God says that He is not going to do something, I can rest assured that He will not. For example, God says that He can not lie (Titus 1:2). But isn't God all powerful, and if He is, can't He lie? He can't because He put Himself in a box that says He can not lie. Therefore, if God says that something is going to happen one way, then I can rest assured that it is not going to happen some other way. With all that out of the way, let's continue. Premillennialist rest the 1000 year reign of Christ on one verse within the book of Revelation. They claim that because of this verse that when Christ returns that all who are on the Earth will dwell in peace with Him for 1000 years. So what is the verse and what does it say. Revelation 20:4 ***“And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.”***

I want you to notice two things about this verse that the Premillennialist conveniently overlook. First, no where in this verse does it talk about Christ returning to the Earth. The word Earth is not mentioned in this verse or even in the entire chapter of Revelation 20. To come to the conclusion that Christ is reigning on the Earth you would have to make a mere assumption. Second, look back up at this verse and you will see, if this was a literal reign, who would be with Christ during said reign. Only those who were beheaded because they were Christians. That would exclude everyone who would be alive, those who have died already due to other causes, and even would exclude those who have been murdered for being Christians by any other way other than being beheaded.

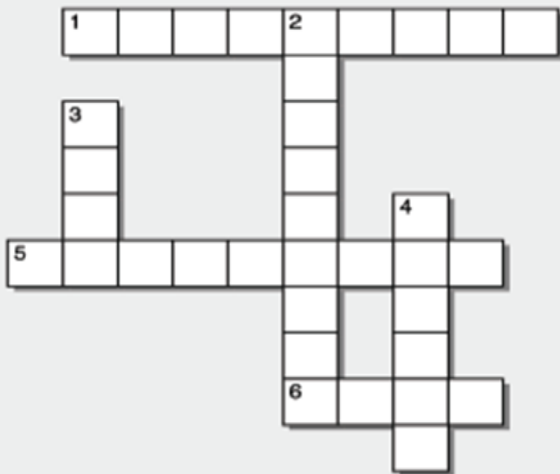

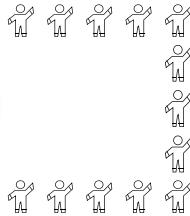
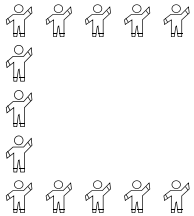
