We should be wearing Christ daily. Paul wrote to the brethren in the region of Galatia **“For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ,”** Galatians 3:27. Paul is saying that when a person obeys the Gospel by being baptized into Christ, that he/she is putting Christ on like a coat. And this is a coat we never want to remove. Christ is all over us, and by wearing Him, He helps to keep us safe from the outside elements through the Word of God.

We should be longing to be clothed with immortality. **“For we know that if our earthly house, this tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed with our habitation which is from heaven, if indeed, having been clothed, we shall not be found naked. For we who are in this tent groan, being burdened, not because we want to be unclothed, but further clothed, that mortality may be swallowed up by life,”** 2 Corinthians 5:1-4. Paul is not saying that we should all give up and long to die, but rather that we are not to be afraid of dying, because dying in this life is living in the next for the faithful Christian.

We should wear the clothes of humility. **“Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for “GOD RESISTS THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE HUMBLE,”** 1 Peter 5:5. We should be confident in the Lord, but not arrogant in our own being.

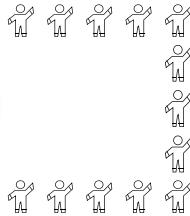
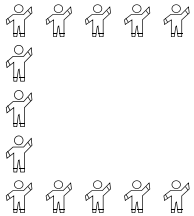
