Are We Prepared

You know, we seem to be a prepared people. But are we really? Let's look at a few things that we do in life to be prepared.

In the spring we till the ground for planting. Then at harvest time, we are ready to gather our bounty. We prepare! When we plan a family, we get ready for that bundle of joy! We prepare! Meteorologist give us information to be safe in bad weather conditions, We prepare! With the situation we are in today we tend to do what medical professionals recommend. We prepare! In most everything we do, we make preparation.

Let's take a look at the ten virgins in Matthew 25:1-13. As you know five were wise and five were foolish. The foolish took their lamps but no oil with them. The wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps with the bridegroom came, the foolish wanted oil from the wise for their lamps had gone out but the wise didn't have enough for both. So when the foolish went to get more oil, the bridegroom came, those that were ready went in. They were prepared! Afterward came the foolish saying "Lord, Lord, open to us. He answered and said 'Verily I say unto you, I know you not." They were unprepared.

An important verse in this passage is verse 13. "Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the night wherein the Son of Man cometh." In a similar verse 1 Thessalonians 5:2 states "For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night."

Think about the song "Prepare to meet thy God." "Careless soul, why do you linger, wondering from the fold of God? He you not the invitation? O prepare to meet thy God!"

We don't know when our life will end. We are in difficult times, we are only a heartbeat away from eternity. Plus, as the scripture tells us, we know not when the Lord might return!

If we are not prepared, we need to start making preparation <u>NOW!</u> Remember, there is a prepared place for a <u>prepared</u> people... Heaven!
