As many of you know, we have been in the process of adopting Eliana now for out 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ years. Now that we have an attorney locally, we pray that it will be finalized soon. There are many children in this world who are seeking to be adopted and loved by loving parents. Just as in our physical lives, we do not want to grow up with parent(s) who do not care for us; neither should we in our spiritual lives! Although most don't want to admit it, one is either under Satan's control or he/she has submitted to Christ. Paul writes "Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are that one's slaves whom you obey, whether of sin leading to death, or of obedience leading to righteousness," Romans 6:16. In other words, I either belong to Christ or Satan; there is no in between. And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ," Galatians 4:4-7. So the question remains, are you adopted? If not, why not? "And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely," Revelation 22:17.


