## Look at all that bright, white snow

Monday morning, we woke up to a beautiful sight of snow on the ground. Although there was not much, it was enough to cover the ground. While looking at all the bright, white snow, I was reminded of the words penned by the inspired prophet Isaiah; **“Come now, and let us reason together,” Says the LORD, “Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool,”** Isaiah 1:18. As I think of the love that God has for mankind, it still amazes me that no matter how bad of a person one may be, he/she can still obey the commands of God and become pure as the bright white snow. Some people may think that they are “too far gone” for God to forgive them and that they have committed too many sins to become a Christian. However, when one studies his/her Bible, he/she will see that many “bad” people were forgiven by God and had their sins cleansed just as the snow. **“Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.,”** 1 Corinthians 6:9-10. Paul was writing to the Gentile brethren at Corinth who were some of the worst transgressors of God’s Law on the planet. But look what Paul writes in the very next verse; **“And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God,”** 1 Corinthians 6:11. Paul himself was an accessory to murder, **“and they cast him out of the city and stoned him. And the witnesses laid down their clothes at the feet of a young man named Saul. And they stoned Stephen as he was calling on God and saying, “Lord Jesus, receive my spirit,”** Acts 7:58-59; and persecutor of the church, **“For you have heard of my former conduct in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God beyond measure and tried to destroy it.,”** Galatians 1:13. However, Paul was forgiven when He repented (turning from his sinful lifestyle and turning to God), and was baptized, having his sins washed away, **“And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord,”** Acts 22:16. What if the Lord returned today - right now, would He find your sins to be red as scarlet or as white as snow.

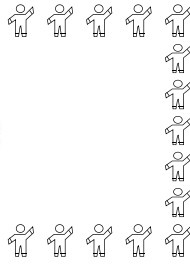
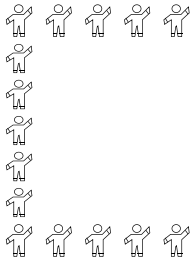
