Getting into Spiritual Shape Mckinley Pate

Here it is, another year and another year of resolutions. Many of us (myself included) will resolve to get into better physical shape this year. However, it is high time that the world in general, as well as the Lord's people, get into spiritual shape. How can one get into spiritual shape? Let me offer three simple suggestions.

- 1. Study the Word of God. One can easily see what God desires for our spiritual health by studying the Word of God. The Apostle Peter, by inspiration of the Holy Spirit, wrote, "According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue," 2 Peter 1:3. God has given us all things that pertain to life and godliness through the knowledge of Him, but how do we know Him? By studying His Word. "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth," 2 Timothy 2:15.
- 2. Steadiness in prayer. It is often times stated that communication is a two way street. God communicates with us today through His Word, the Bible. "God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, has in these last days spoken to us by His Son...," Hebrews 1:1-2. We, in, turn communicate to God through the avenue of prayer. Jesus often communicated to the Father through the avenue of prayer and He taught His disciples to pray. "In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name," Matthew 6:9. As Jesus continued to teach them how to pray, He stated that they should pray that they are not led into temptation, but delivered from evil (Matthew 6:13). We must remember that no matter what is going on in our lives that we can pray to God and that He is listening, "casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you," I Peter 5:7.
- 3. **Submit to the Will of God**. There is a popular thought today that states that all can do what they want, worship God the way they want, and find salvation any way they want. It has been said that we are all going to heaven; however, we are just taking different roads. These ideas are foreign to the Bible. The inspired Jeremiah wrote "O LORD, I know the way of man is not in himself; It is not in man who walks to direct his own steps," Jeremiah 10:23. Jesus said "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me," John 14:6. We must put aside our prejudices and simply look to the Word of God for the will of God. "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God," Romans 12:2. But what is God's will? Simply put that all men be saved. "who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth," I Timothy 2:4.
