# Starting The New Year Off Right! <u>Mckinley Pate</u>

At the beginning of every year, people often reflect on the previous year and how they can improve on the upcoming year. We, as Christians, should use this time to reflect on our spiritual lives. Paul wrote to the Corinthian brethren, "**Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you are disqualified.**," 2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 13:5. We need to examine ourselves to see if we are living the spiritual lives that God would have us to live. Do our co-workers or school mates know that we are Christians? Have I set my mind to doing the Lord's work or am I focused too much on earthly things? "Set your mind on things **above, not on things on the earth.**," Colossians 3:2. Is Jesus a priority in my life or is He just a Sunday after-thought? Let us look at three simple questions, and let us each examine ourselves and see if we truly have Jesus as a priority in our lives.

- 1) Am I a student of the Word of God? How many hours apart from corporate Bible study do I open my Bible and study God's Word? "Oh, how I love Your law! It is my meditation all the day.," Psalm 119:97. "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth," 2<sup>nd</sup> Timothy 2:15 (K|V).
- 2) Am I serious about worship? We come together to worship God for about one hour each Sunday morning and one hour each Sunday afternoon. That averages up to about 104 hours each year to worship God. Every Sunday there are many who, because of illness, cannot attend worship services. These people would give anything to be able to attend services for just one more hour. "not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.," Hebrews 10:25.
- 3) Am I serving in the work of the Lord? Am I promoting or hindering the cause of Christ in this community? Am I a worker for the Lord? "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them," Ephesians 2:10.

Let us make sure that we are starting the New Year off right in the Lord.
