Is the Rapture a real thing? <u>Mckinley Pate</u>

So now that we have drove off the cliff into this downward spiral called Premillennialism, we must look at another part of this teaching that is referred to as the rapture. We must ask three questions with regard to the rapture.

- 1. What is the Premillennialist view of the rapture? The Premillennial view of the rapture is that Christ will return one day and rapture up all those who are "saved" into the clouds to meet with Him. Once in the clouds, Christ will take the "saved" onto heaven without the lost knowing it and those who are left behind will suffer seven years of tribulation (which we will talk more about the tribulation next week). After the sever years of tribulation, the raptured souls will return to earth to live in 1000 year reign with Christ sitting on David's literal throne in Jerusalem. Then after the 1000 years is up Christ will return a second-second time and judge the all souls. Sounds like the making of a great Hollywood movie or an even better bumper sticker. "In case of the rapture this vehicle will be unmanned.
- 2. Does the Bible even speak of a rapture? The simple answer is yes. "For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord," | Thessalonians 4:16-17. The word "Caught up" in this passage is the Greek word that means rapture.
- 3. Are the Premillennialist view and the Biblical view the same? No they are not. In the Biblical view, when Christ returns, those who are faithful Christians will be raptured or caught up to meet Christ in the air and then the world will be destroyed with fire. "But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up," 2 Peter 3:9. When Christ returns, it will not be a secret. "Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen," Revelation 1:7. Next week, Lord willing we will look at the tribulation and 1000 year reign of Christ.


