# Where Are You Leading Others?

From time to time we sing the song titled, "Where He Leads I'll Follow". We should follow Jesus because of His perfect example and pattern for us. Paul said in 1Thess.5:21-21 to accept those things that are "good" and to not have anything to do with that which is "evil". Certainly this warning should be heeded by ALL of us, if we expect to lead others to Christ!

Parents (and/or Grandparents), do you think about where you are leading the precious souls in your care? Are you leading them in the ways of Christ, everyday? We, as parents, have an ever-present influence in our children's lives. Our children will only see the great need to follow Jesus, if they see that we love Christ and truly desire to follow Him ourselves! If we do not show them the importance of study and prayer, they will not consider it important. If we do not show them that worshipping/studying together with fellow Christians (every time the church meets), is essential for strength and growth, then they will not see anything wrong in being absent for whatever reason. If we do not show them a servant heart (one like Christ), then we are leading them towards a life of selfishness. Surely, we want to lead those closest to us (and everyone) to Christ (to Salvation/to God/to Heaven). Where are YOU leading?
