# In the world you will have tribulation! Mckinley Pate

Two weeks ago, we looked at the false doctrine of the "rapture," where this doctrine teaches that the Church will be raptured to heaven secretly and those who are left behind will begin to go through seven years of tribulation. As we pointed out a few weeks back that there are also those who believe that the Church will be raptured in the middle of the tribulation and those who believe that they will be raptured after the seven years of tribulation. Those who believe in the tribulation, say that this will be the time for those who are not "saved" to make things right with God and become "saved," while the others perish. But remember, according to their teaching the Church will not be here on Earth, which begs the question, in the tribulation when one is "saved" are they not part of the Church?

So what does the bible say. The word tribulation is mentioned 22 times within the Bible and not once is it associated with a certain time period of seven years or any other. In fact John stated that he was already in tribulation when he wrote the book of Revelation. And we know that was written a lot longer than seven years ago. "I, John, both your brother and companion in the tribulation and kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was on the island that is called Patmos for the word of God and for the testimony of Jesus Christ," Revelation 1:9. Jesus stated to the Apostles that they as long as we are in the world that they along with us would have tribulation. "These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world," John 16:33. We also know that the only second chance we have is here and now. There will not be an extra chance when Christ returns for the judgment. Paul wrote by inspiration and said "For He says: "IN AN ACCEPTABLE TIME I HAVE HEARD YOU, AND IN THE DAY OF SALVATION I HAVE HELPED YOU." Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation," 2 Corinthians 6:2.

So where do they come up with this idea. Simple, it is a bad understanding of Matthew 24, Daniel 12, the book of Revelation and other passages. This type of false doctrine is why it is so important for us to STUDY our bibles! Next up is the 1000 year physical reign of Christ here on Earth.


