Is Matthew 24 about the End of Times (cont.)

As you remember from our last study, Jesus told his disciples that all the things that He was talking about would come upon **“this generation,”** Matthew 23:36. He then told His disciples that the temple would be destroyed (Matthew 24:2). His disciples asked Him three questions... **“Tell us, when will these things be? And what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?”** Matthew 24:3 Jesus does exactly what everyone would do when asked multiple questions. He answers them one at a time, beginning with the first question, **“Tell us, when will these things (the destruction of the temple) be?”** Jesus responded **“Take heed that no one deceives you. For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many. And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. All these are the beginning of sorrows,”** Matthew 24:4-8. And He continues to tell them of all the bad things that will happen and states this in verse 34, **“Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all these things take place.”** Jesus clearly tells them that everything that He had said from back in chapter 23 all the way to verse 34 of chapter 24 will happen to that generation. If Jesus is answering the question about His second coming, then there are a lot of people walking around this earth that are still alive that were living when Jesus made that statement two thousand years ago. Remember a generation is less than 50 years, therefore all that Jesus was saying between Matthew 23:36 to Matthew 24:34 was going to happen within the next 50 years. Jesus did not give them an exact date for the occurrence, rather just generalizing it to that generation. And it did happen with the destruction of Jerusalem in A.D. 70. Many believe that in Matthew 24:36 and following that Jesus begins to answer the second and third questions. However, some (including myself, although I could be completely wrong) believe that all of Matthew 24 refers to the first question asked (destruction of Jerusalem) and that He began to answer the second and third question with Chapter 25. Therefore, just because we are having wars, famine and earthquakes does not mean that we are seeing the signs of the end of times. There will be no signs of Jesus’ return, **“Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming,”** Matthew 25:13. Next week we will continue to look at these false signs, Lord willing.

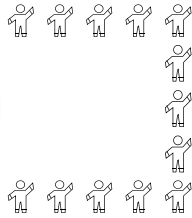
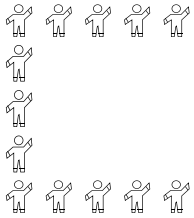
