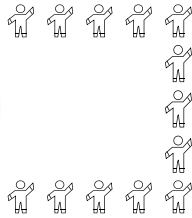
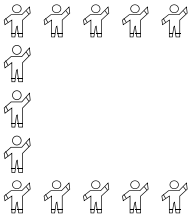
Rejoicing:
