It was because of this woman going into her own community and spreading the news about Jesus. And was what was the response? "Then they went out of the city and came to Him," John 4:30. "And many of the Samaritans of that city believed in Him because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me all that I ever did." So when the Samaritans had come to Him, they urged Him to stay with them; and He stayed there two days. And many more believed because of His own word," John 4:39-41.

What about when persecution came upon the 1st century Church? "Therefore those who were scattered went everywhere preaching the word," Acts 8:4. The epidemy of community spread.

Can you imagine what will happen right here in the Greenhill community if we began to practice "Community Spreading" of the Gospel! Let's try it and see!
