There is not a person in the world who can live totally above sin. Paul told us in Romans 3:23 that **“All have sinned”** and in John 1:8 says, **“If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.”** Everyone makes mistakes and fails a little short of what he would like to be!

This is why we have Jesus. When we sin and fall down He is there to help. If we could live perfect lives, there would be no need for Christ. 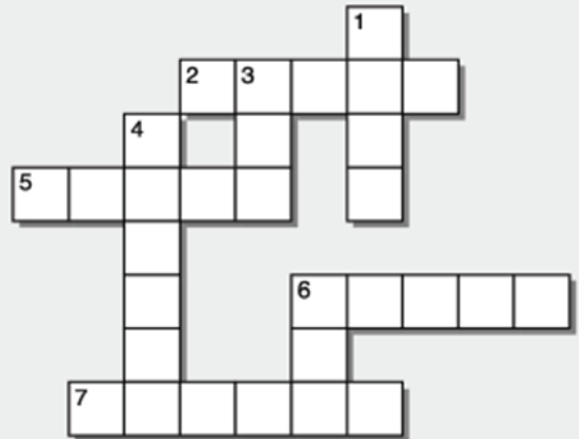

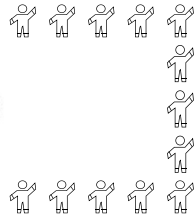
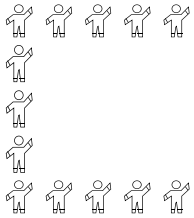
