Guidelines to resume in person services at the Shiloh Church of Christ

The following guidelines regarding resuming in person services at the Shiloh Church of Christ building beginning June 7, 2020 are from the Eldership of the Shiloh Church of Christ.

We ask that those who do not feel comfortable in resuming in person meeting to remain home and Worship with us online. If you are sick or running a fever, please remain home and Worship with us via the internet.

We ask that all attendees follow the guidelines given by the State with regards to social distancing. We urge those who are not of the same household to maintain six (6) feet of distance between persons.

Every other pew will be blocked off with pews being staggered on the opposite side of the aisle. Please use social distancing between families of at least six (6) feet.

Services will be held at 10 a.m. on Sundays only until otherwise stated from the Eldership. We will not have any Bible Classes or evening services on Sunday and our Wednesday Bible Study will remain as live stream only at 6:30 on Facebook and YouTube.

Only the front doors will be unlocked and propped open for entrance to the building. Again, please maintain social distancing as you enter the building. Please go directly into the auditorium and be seated and do not linger around to socialize in the building. We are aware that one of the best parts of being a member at Shiloh is all of the wonderful fellowship we have for one another, however for the time being, we will have to sacrifice for the physical safety of all.

Mask are not required, however are strongly encouraged, especially during the song service. If you do not have a mask and want one, please let one of the Ushers know and they will get you one. We ask that you do not put your mask on until you reach the awning at the front door.

We will provide an overflow room in the fellowship hall if we reach capacity.

Due to sanitation issues we will not have songbooks, member cards, nor visitor cards in the pews. We will be singing using the PowerPoint slides only.

After the closing prayer, please remain seated and in your pew. The Ushers will dismiss each side by rows as to help maintain the social distancing guidelines.


