The Brevity of Life Mckinley Pate

On November 19, 2012, my grandmother, Doris Heath, passed from this life onto the next. (12) So teach us to number our days, That we may gain a heart of wisdom."** The comfort in saying goodbye to Grandmother was in the fact that she was a faithful Christian. Later in that same book John wrote, **"Then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, 'Write: 'Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.' " "Yes," says the Spirit, "that they may rest from their labors, and their works follow them,"** Revelation 14:13. She lived her life to bring honor and glory to God. She looked forward to every Sunday and Wednesday, knowing that on those two days that she would be able to study and worship God with like-minded brethren at the small Church of Christ in Spruce Pine Alabama. 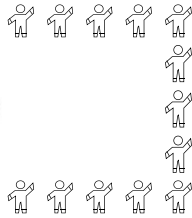
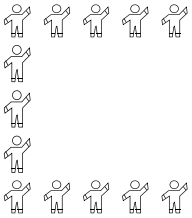
