Standing up for what's right can make things worse before they get better. Like when Moses went to Pharaoh and said it was time to let the people go. I'm sure the enslaved Israelites were thrilled that someone was sticking up for them. But not for long. Pharaoh's response was to make their slave labor a lot harder, and then the leaders go back to Moses and say, "May the Lord look on you and judge you!" But do you know this story?
