# Can a person be "kicked out" of the Church? Mckinley Pate

The church does not "kick" anyone out of the church as some exclaim. The church does however practice discipline just as parents do. When our children do something wrong we, as parents, don't pat them on the back and say "way to go." Rather we, out of sincere love for them, show them that they were in the wrong and try to have them correct that wrong behavior. In the church the same happens to God's children. When God's children commit public sin or bring reproach upon the church, our goal as Christians should always be to have that individual or individuals correct that sin. John stated "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.," I John 1:9.

But how does discipline take place? If someone sins we have to follow the guidelines that Jesus set forth in Matthew 18. ""Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother. But if he will not hear, take with you one or two more, that 'BY THE MOUTH OF TWO OR THREE WITNESSES EVERY WORD MAY BE ESTABLISHED.' And if he refuses to hear them, tell it to the church. But if he refuses even to hear the church, let him be to you like a heathen and a tax collector.," Matthew 18:15-17. Our goal is to have that brother or sister correct his/ her mistake and once again be a faithful follower of God. Unfortunately sometimes the one who sins will let pride stand in his/her way and he/she will not repent of his/her wrong doing. When that is the case, we as Christians, must stick to what the Bible tells us to do. "But we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you withdraw from every brother who walks disorderly and not according to the tradition which he received from us.," 2 Thessalonians 3:6. "Reject a divisive man after the first and second admonition, knowing that such a person is warped and sinning, being self-condemned.," Titus 3:10-11. We do not do this out of hate but rather out of love, hoping and praying that he/she will repent. "And if anyone does not obey our word in this epistle, note that person and do not keep company with him, that he may be ashamed. Yet do not count him as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.," 2 Thessalonians 3:14-15. When a congregation has to withdraw fellowship from a brother or sister in Christ, it is a very hard thing. However, sometimes this must be done in hopes of saving the souls of not only those walking disorderly but also the souls of the church. Let us remember that everything that we do in life, not only in the church, must be done out of love and not out of spite. Let us continue to pray for those whom we have had to withdraw fellowship from, but also remember that until he/she repents we cannot have fellowship with that person/persons.
