For Whom Shall I Vote?

Here we are just over one week from what many say is the most important election in the history of the United States of America. You may be saying to yourself, “wait a minute preacher, you’re supposed to talk about spiritual things and not dive into politics.” You’re right! That is why before you go and vote for either a donkey or an elephant, we examine the Lamb and see how we as Christians should vote.

Abortion is murder and God hates it. **“These six things the LORD hates, Yes, seven are an abomination to Him: A proud look, A lying tongue, Hands that shed innocent blood,”** Proverbs 6:16-17. 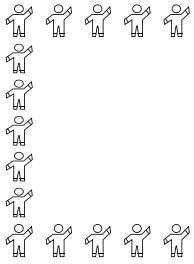

We know that there are so many who are unable, due to this virus to be with us this morning, but we are grateful for you being here and for the opportunity to be able to reach so many with the avenue of the internet.

This morning we will begin our look at the churches of Asia found in the book of Revelation. These lessons will take us to the end of the year. Today we will start by looking at the church Ephesus.
