Now let's take this one step further. But there is another reason why Christ will not come back to Earth and establish an earthly kingdom like the Premillennialist state. It is simply that the Kingdom that Christ established is a spiritual one and not a physical one. If Christ wanted to establish a physical Kingdom He would have done just that as He had two separate occasions to do just that. In Matthew 4:8-9 Satan offered to give all the Kingdoms to Christ "Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. And he said to Him, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me." And a second time recorded in the book of John Jesus had the chance to establish an earthly Kingdom, but He didn't. "Therefore when Jesus perceived that they were about to come and take Him by force to make Him king, He departed again to the mountain by Himself alone," John 6:15. However, according to Jesus Himself, His Kingdom was going to be spiritual and not physical. "Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The kingdom of God does not come with observation; nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you," Luke 17:20-21

Remember Premillennialist state that the reason we have the Church is because God didn't see the Jews rejecting Jesus and therefore Jesus was not able to set up His earthly Kingdom and so the Church is just a temporary replacement until Christ returns to set up His kingdom and reign 1000 years. The Greek term for that thinking is "Hogwash." We know that the Church was always the plan of God. It is because of the Church that the angelic beings finally understand God's purpose and plan. "to the intent that now the manifold wisdom of God might be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places, according to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord," Ephesians 3:10-11. Lord willing, next week will finish up by looking at the final reason, according to the Bible, that Christ will not reign over an earthly kingdom!


