<u>The 1000 Year Reign of Christ—Part 4</u> <u>Mckinley Pate</u>

We have already looked at plenty of scriptures that would destroy the Premillennialist idea of the 1000 year reign of Christ. However, as I often do, I don't want to leave any room for doubt. And obviously God didn't either, because there is another reason why Christ will not return to earth upon His second coming to set up an earthly kingdom and rule on earth for a 1000 years. Let's check it out.

In Jeremiah 22, God begins to denounce a king from the Southern Kingdom of Judah by the name of Jeconiah (or Coniah as used in the these passages). "As I live," says the LORD, "though Coniah the son of Jehoiakim, king of Judah, were the signet on My right hand, yet I would pluck you off; (28-30) "Is this man Coniah a despised, broken idol—A vessel in which is no pleasure? Why are they cast out, he and his descendants, And cast into a land which they do not know? O earth, earth, earth, Hear the word of the LORD! Thus says the LORD: 'Write this man down as childless, A man who shall not prosper in his days; For none of his descendants shall prosper, Sitting on the throne of David, And ruling anymore in Judah.'
" Jeremiah 22:24, 28-30. What God is saying here is that no one in the seed line of Jeconiah would ever rule again on earth, ever! So what does that have to do with Christ. Let's keep digging.

"The sons of Josiah were Johanan the firstborn, the second Jehoiakim, the third Zedekiah, and the fourth Shallum. The sons of Jehoiakim were Jeconiah his son and Zedekiah his son. And the sons of Jeconiah were Assir, Shealtiel his son," 2 Chronicles 3:15-17. Here the descendants and predecessors of Jeconiah are listed. Now we are going to fast forward to the linage of Christ in Matthew, however, we must remember that the Jews did not call their grandchildren grand, they were just known as sons. Therefore, if you were Jewish your children's children would be called your sons or daughters, not your grandsons or granddaughters. Confusing? I know!

"Josiah begot Jeconiah and his brothers about the time they were carried away to Babylon," Matthew 1:11. Here Matthew is giving the linage of Jesus and who is in His linage, none other than Jeconiah who God stated that none of his descendants would be sitting on David's throne here on earth. However we know that Christ is on David's Throne today and that throne is not a physical one, but a spiritual one.


