<u>The 1000 year reign of Christ Part 2</u> <u>Mckinley Pate</u>

As we discussed last week, if Christ was to return to the Earth for a "so -called" 1000 year reign, the only ones who would be with him would be those who have been beheaded for the cause of Christ (Revelation 20:4).

We also noted that no where in their "sugar stick verse" does it say that Christ is coming back to Earth to reign. In fact, no where in scripture does it say that Christ will physically come back to the Earth. Paul, through inspiration writes that when Christ returns that the faithful will meet Him in the air, "For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord," I Thessalonians 4:16-17. According to this verse, Christ's feet will not touch the Earth.

We know from the Bible that Christ's reign is a spiritual one and that it is happening right now, "and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood," Revelation 1:5. Jesus, Himself, said that His rule is happening now as He gave the Apostle's the Great Commission. "And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth," Matthew 28:18. The word "authority" in this verse means "rule." In fact the Bible states that Jesus rule over His Kingdom will cease after His second coming as He returns His authority to the Father. "Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. The last enemy that will be destroyed is death," I Corinthians 15:24-26. When will death be destroyed? It will be destroyed in the final resurrection. "And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away." Revelation 21:4. Christ reign is happening now and He does not (nor

will not) have to return to Earth to begin His reign. Lord willing next week we will see that Christ was never meant to reign on a physical throne on Earth.


